**NAVY ANNOUNCES MORE THAN 30 REPRIMANDS IN USS ENTERPRISE  
HARASSMENT CASE**

*Service Women's Action Network (SWAN) Praises US Fleet Forces Commander, Adm.  
John Harvey for Holding Navy Leaders Accountable*

New York, NY-Today the Navy announced that it was reprimanding Capt. Owen Honors, and more than 30 officers and senior enlisted sailors, including 6 Admirals, in the investigation into the USS Enterprise's "XO Movie Night" scandal. Capt. Honors lost command of the USS Enterprise earlier this year as a result of producing a series of lewd, sexist, and homophobic videos that were shown onboard the ship.

"The decision to punish the leaders on the Enterprise, including six senior-level Admirals, is the right thing to do," said Anu Bhagwati, former Marine Corps Captain and executive director of the Service Women's Action Network (SWAN). "Military leaders are responsible for protecting their troops by ensuring a command climate that is free from harassment, intimidation, discrimination and assault. This scandal was a clear failure of that leadership at all levels."

"SWAN urges the Secretary of the Navy to approve the punishments recommended by the Fleet Forces Commander as quickly as possible."

SWAN is spearheading a national advocacy campaign to change the military's response to rape, sexual assault and sexual harassment.
